## **Notice of Non-use of "Conflict Minerals"**

Dear Sirs,

We Capacitor Business Unit, Panasonic Electronic Devices Co., Ltd. notify Panasonic film capacitor<sup>(\*1)</sup> do not directly or indirectly use "Conflict Minerals" from mines which directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or adjoining countries. The "Conflict Minerals" includes, but no limit to, cassiterite, wolframite coltan, gold or derivatives especially for four metals (tungsten, tin, tantalum, and gold).

We will immediately discontinue doing business with any supplier found to be purchasing materials which directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or adjoining countries. We will continue to work with our suppliers towards the goal of greater transparency in the supply chain. When the new facts are found, we will immediately deal with them.
